Assessing Voluntary Experience

- No one treats voluntary work in this way
 - It is completely new that it can be measured and described
- No direct relation between voluntary and professional work
 - Voluntary is perceived as kindness
 - Being helpful is the reason of undertaking voluntary work



Assessing Voluntary Experience

- Lack of awareness that voluntary work can be a way of improving qualifications
 - It can be changed in the future
- Huge unemployment
 - "+" voluntary gives opportunity to gain some experience
 - "-" voluntary does not help in getting job, because there is no job
